Step 3: We Will Erect Containment

Any time there is the presence of hazardous materials special care and caution must be exercised before, during and after the removal process.

Proper Containment Means We:

- Will seal off the entire area to prevent any possible cross-contamination into other areas. These "cleaning chambers" can only be accessed by licensed, trained personnel wearing special equipment.
- Special filtering equipment will be placed within the chamber to guarantee that no airborne contaminants can escape. For everyone's safety these areas are always clearly marked and secured.
- Depending on the severity of the mold infestation, additional equipment may be placed both within and outside of the containment to ensure a healthy environment.

Step 4: We Will Remove the Hazardous Materials
